Registration for membership in "A League of Our Own WWII Girls Baseball Living History League" is open to all women who desire to participate in our women's vintage softball league. It is strongly suggested that members who are interested in playing ball, should have some basic 12" softball playing skills. The League represents the style of game play, 12" underhand pitch softball, played by the women of the All-American Girls Professional Ball League (AAGPBL) during the war years 1943-45; whose players were among the best in the world. We do our best to represent their level of play as honestly as we are able. Also be aware that we are a vintage ball club and therefore spend about half our time sharing the history of the AAGPBL with the public at many of our events. Our organization is a full member of the Vintage Base Ball Association (VBBA).

Players are expected to possess a basic level of softball playing skills; be willing to participate in at least 2 league events a year; be willing to make or have made for them, a league approved reproduction uniform with materials and instructions from the league at least one year from time of joining. League members shall be at least 18 years of age, or 16-17 with a legal guardian's approval and active membership in the league (player or non player role); and willing to represent the league cheerfully with the public at all times. Above all, like the original league, our players will be "Ladies" and expected to respect the rules and customs of the AAGPBL when ever in uniform or representing the league.

Non-player members, and this includes any men interested in participating in the league, are welcome in any number of auxiliary roles such as coaches, umpires, chaperones, photographers, play by play announcers, fans, etc..
