Registration for membership in the WWII Girls Baseball Living History league is open to all women who desire to participate in a women's vintage recreational softball league. It is strongly suggested that members who are interested in playing ball, should have some basic softball playing skills and abilities. The League represents the style of ball played by the women of the All-American Girls Professional Ball League (AAGPBL) during the years 1943-45; whose players were among the best in the world. We do our best to represent their level of play as honestly as we can.

Players are expected to possess a basic level of softball playing skills; be willing to participate in at least 6 league games and/or events in South East Wisconsin, Northern Illinois and North West Indiana, per season; be willing to purchase an official AAGPBL uniform from our approved uniform vendor within a year; and physically up to playing softball. League members shall be at least 18 years of age or 16-17 with a legal guardian's approval & active membership in the league; and willing to represent the WWII Women's Baseball League cheerfully with the public at all times; above all, like the original league, our players will be "Ladies" and expected to respect the rules and customs of the AAGPBL whenever you are in uniform. Non-player members, and this includes any men interested in participating in the league, are welcome in any number of auxiliary roles such as coaches, umpires, chaperones, photographers, play by play announcers, fans, etc..
